

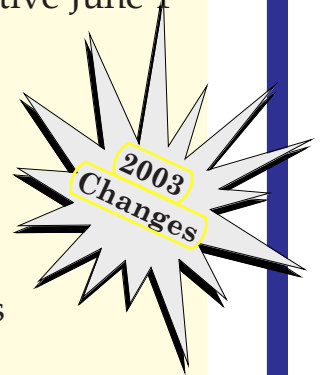

2003 Legislative Changes Go Into Effect!

Significant changes to the lawful gambling laws are taking place.
The changes, which impact all licensed organizations, include:

- Rent reform (new limits established) - effective June 1
- Fee changes - effective July 1
- Licensing changes (new forms!)
- Lawful purpose expenditures
- Definitions (clarifying changes)
- Pull-tab prize payout limit (85%)
- Linked bingo - What is it?
- Gambling manager education requirements
- Employee identification
