**Agenda:** HF1798 (Kohls) Secretary of State filing procedures simplified, certain filing requirements eliminated, electronic registration required, and money appropriated

**HF1835 (Seifert)** *A bill for an act relating to veterans; expanding the definition of lawful purpose of lawful gambling to include payment for expenses of sending certain veterans to National World War II Memorial dedication events. (Senate Companion is SF 1796)*

HF1690 (Brod) Veterans Affairs Commissioner authorized to access taxpayer identification information to notify veterans of possible health hazards and benefits.

- 1.13 the dedication events of the National World War II Memorial on
- 1.14 May 27 to May 30, 2004.
- 1.15 Sec. 2. [EFFECTIVE DATE.]
- 1.16 Section 1 is effective the day following final enactment.
