- 1.7 Section 1. [LAWFUL PURPOSE.]
- 1.8 Notwithstanding the definition of "lawful purpose" in
- 1.9 Minnesota Statutes, section 349.12, subdivision 25, it is a
- 1.10 lawful purpose of lawful gambling conducted by a licensed
- 1.11 veterans organization to pay up to \$1,500 per person to send up
- 1.12 to two World War II veterans per post to Washington D.C., for
- 1.13 the dedication events of the National World War II Memorial on
- 1.14 May 27 to May 30, 2004.
- 1.15 Sec. 2. [EFFECTIVE DATE.]
- 1.16 Section 1 is effective the day following final enactment.
