

Legislative Recess - Great Opportunity To Contact Legislators

The Minnesota Legislature will have a Passover/Easter recess from Monday afternoon, April 2, 2007 until Tuesday noon, April 10, 2007. **As most legislators will be home during this legislative recess we strongly encourage ALL charitable gambling organization and company members and employees to contact their Minnesota State Senator and Representative at home using the sample phone messages printed below.**

If we want to see **SF 1966/HF 1691** as outlined in the 3/30/07 ACM Legislative Update/ALERT sent out last Friday passed this legislative session we need you to ask YOUR Minnesota State Senator during the legislative recess to *please ask the members of the Senate State and Local Government Operations and Oversight Committee to hear and pass ACM's charitable gambling policy bill ... SF 1966 by the policy deadline on April 14th.* If we want to see charitable gambling taxes reduced this year we need you to ask YOUR Minnesota State Representative during the legislative recess to *please make sure a reduction of charitable gambling taxes is included in the 2007 House Omnibus Tax Bill.*

At the very least we need the CEO & Gambling Manager of ALL licensed charitable gambling organizations to contact their local legislators. Please take the time to contact YOUR local Minnesota State Legislators during the legislative recess. THANKS!!!
