### ACM's 2011 Charitable Gambling Bill Introduced In House

On Thursday, April 14, 2011 *Allied Charities Of Minnesota's 2011 Charitable Gambling Bill* was introduced in the Minnesota House Of Representatives (HF 1485). HF 1485 was referred to the House Commerce and Regulatory Reform Committee.

HF 1485, *Allied Charities Of Minnesota's 2011 Charitable Gambling Bill*, is authored by Representatives **John Kriesel** of Cottage Grove, **David Dill** of Crane Lake, **Tom Tillberry** of Fridley, **Joe Hoppe** of Chaska, **Kurt Zellers** of Maple Grove, **Mark Murdock** of Ottertail, **John Ward** of Brainerd, **Ron Shimanski** of Silver Lake, & **Sondra Erickson** of Princeton. *Allied Charities Of Minnesota's 2011 Charitable Gambling Bill* primarily does 2 things:

1. **SIGNIFICANTLY REDUCES CHARITABLE GAMBLING TAXES (a minimum of 41%).** Bingo, Raffle, & Paddlewheel Tax rate changed from 8.5% to 5%, Pull-Tab & Tipboard Tax rate changed from 1.7% to 1%, Combined Receipts Tax rates changed from 1.7%, 3.4%, 5.1% to 1%, 2%, & 3% and brackets changed from \$500,000-\$700,000, \$700,000-\$900,000, & \$900,000+ to \$600,000-\$800,000, \$800,000-\$1,000,000, & \$1,000,000+, Combined Receipts Tax changed to individual site-by-site basis.

2. **MODERNIZES OUR CURRENT GAMES WITHIN OUR CURRENT STRUCTURE TO ALLOW CHARITABLE GAMBLING ORGANIZATIONS TO SURVIVE & THRIVE IN THE YEARS AHEAD.** Electronic linked bingo and electronic pull-tabs are authorized.

# 2011 Gambling Bill Introductions

Listed below are the 2011 Gambling Bills introduced since the 3.18.11 ACM Legislative Update (thru 4.17.11):

**Senate File (955) 174 (Brown; Thompson; Gerlach) & House File (HF) 1152 (Sanders; Beard)** - Pawnbrokers pledged goods return regulations; location restrictions near gambling casinos repeal.

**SF 944 (Senjem; Scheid)** - Bingo gross profits use for allowable expenses percent increase.

**SF 1031 (Wiger; Goodwin; Cohen; Dibble; Torres Ray) & HF 1309 (Kahn)** - State government appropriations and operations provisions modification.

**SF 1046 (Senjem; Robling; Sparks; Parry; Metzen) & HF 1352 (Gunther; Buesgens; Beard; Hackbarth; Hoppe; McNamara; Hamilton; Garofalo; Leidiger; Bills; McFarlane; Anderson, P.; Torkelson; Erickson; Holberg; Cornish; Kriesel; Woodard)** - State Lottery authorized to establish gaming machines, gaming machine revenue tax imposed, powers and duties provided to the director, and a Minnesota future fund and an industry improvement fund established. *(Racino Bill)*

**SF 1116 (Ingebrigtsen; Tomassoni; Sparks; Wiger; Parry) & HF 1435 (Erickson; Rukavina; Westrom; Franson; Kath; Anderson, B.)** - State Lottery director authorized to adopt rules for video lottery ticket dispensing machines. *(Tavern League Of MN Bill)*

**SF 1164 (Rosen; Harrington; Magnus; Scheid) & HF 1441 (Lanning; Nelson; Hoppe; Hamilton; Lillie; Kriesel; Anderson, P.)** - National football league stadium development plan; Minnesota stadium authority establishment; metropolitan sports facilities commission abolishment.

**HF 1355 (Rukavina; Gunther)** - State Lottery director authorized to establish video lottery terminals, duties and powers provided to director of the State Lottery, video lottery revenues use provided, lawful gambling taxes modified, and clarifying, conforming, and technical changes made.

**HF 1419 (Kriesel; McDonald; Cornish; Hoppe; Garofalo)** - Card clubs allowed to conduct banked high-stakes card games.

**HF 1480 (Gunther; Kriesel)** - Racing commission powers provided, and persons permitted to place certain wagers.

**HF 1485 (Kriesel; Dill; Tillberry; Hoppe; Zellers; Murdock; Ward; Shimanski; Erickson)** - Lawful gambling tax rates modification; linked bingo and electronic pull-tabs authorization. *(Allied Charities Of Minnesota's 2011 Charitable Gambling Bill - Companion to SF 702)*
