House Gambling Bill Action

On Thursday, March 26, 2009 the House Commerce and Labor Committee heard and passed **HF 1512 - ACM's 2009 Electronic Bingo Bill**. An amendment which basically spells out the gross profit allocation for electronic bingo and removes the section which would have allowed pull-tab dispensers to be allowed in new locations that are not licensed liquor sites was adopted. The amended bill was recommended to pass and was sent to the Minnesota House of Representatives. **HF 1512** received its second reading on April 1, 2009 and is now on the House General Register.

On Tuesday, April 28, 2009 the House Finance Committee heard and passed **HF 1511 - Gambling Control Board's 2009 Charitable Gambling Policy Bill**. An amendment changing annual audit requirements, putting a cap on the civil penalty that may be imposed on organizations that fail to meet profitability minimums was adopted. An amendment removing section which would have allowed paddle wheels to be turned or spun manually or electronically was adopted. The amended bill was recommended to pass and was re-referred to the House Ways and Means Committee which has scheduled a hearing for **HF 1511** on Monday May 4, 2009.

Senate Gambling Bill Action

On Monday, March 30, 2009 the Senate State and Local Government Operations and Oversight Committee heard and passed **SF 1284 - Gambling Control Board's 2009 Charitable Gambling Policy Bill**. A GCB technical was adopted. The amended bill was recommended to pass and was re-referred to the Senate Judiciary Committee.

On Thursday, April 2, 2009 the Senate Judiciary Committee heard and passed **SF 1284 - Gambling Control Board's 2009 Charitable Gambling Policy Bill**. An amendment putting a cap on the civil penalty that may be imposed on organizations that fail to meet profitability minimums was adopted. The amended bill was recommended to pass and was re-referred to the Senate Finance Committee. Bill was sent by the chair to the State Government Budget Division. Bill was sent to Finance because of fiscal note relating to fees in the bill.

On Monday, April 27, 2009 the Senate State Government Budget Division heard and passed **SF 1284 - Gambling Control Board's 2009 Charitable Gambling Policy Bill**. An amendment changing annual audit requirements was adopted. The amended bill was recommended to pass and was re-referred to the Senate Finance Committee.

On Friday, May 1, 2009 the Senate Finance Committee heard and passed **SF 1284 - Gambling Control Board's 2009 Charitable Gambling Policy Bill**. No amendments were offered in this committee. The bill as amended by the State Government Division was recommended to pass and was re-referred to the Minnesota Senate and will receive its second reading early next week and then be placed on Senate General Orders.

Senate File (SF) 1874 (Metzen; Gerlach; Sparks; Tomassoni; Wiger) - Lawful gambling taxes modifications. *(ACM Bill - Companion to HF 1406)*

SF 1875 (Metzen; Gerlach; Sparks; Tomassoni; Wiger) - Electronic bingo authorization and pull-tab dispensing devices modifications. *(ACM Bill - Companion to HF 1512)*

SF 2007 (Metzen; Tomassoni; Day; Senjem; Robling) & House File (HF) 2339 (Demmer; Buesgens; Hackbarth; Smith; Beard; Garofalo; Brod) - State Lottery director authorized to establish lottery gaming machines and enter into a contract for the management and placement of the machines, powers and duties provided, and gaming machines revenue provided (racino).

SF 2019 (Rest; Lourey) & HF 2253 (Dill; Anzelc) - Lawful gambling taxes modifications. *(GCB Bill)*

HF 2354 (Kahn; Juhnke; Solberg; Haws) - State Lottery director authorized to operate slot machines at the Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport.
